The Fish Friendly Farming/Napa Green program is enrolling new sites. You don't need to have a creek on your site to qualify, every vineyard site from the ridgetop to the river can enroll. The program will be **FREE** for 2012 as grant funding has been received. This is the **only** program approved as compliance under the Vineyard Waiver for the TMDL. **ALL** agricultural lands must complete a Farm Plan to be in compliance with the waiver by 2014. This program also provides a third-party objective certification and allows for marketing of wine with a science based certification. The Ca. Land Stewardship Institute (CLSI), a Napa-based nonprofit organization, directs the program. Nearly 50,000 acres are enrolled in Napa County. CLSI assists landowners to implement projects and finds grant funds to cover project costs. Workshops are held in January and February and then a site visit is done. Several months later you receive your farm plan and are ready to be certified.
